PREPARING FOR SMALL GROUPS

Talk and listen to God

As you work through the studies in preparation for camp, this reflective approach might give you deeper understanding. You may find it useful in partnership with the speaker's notes and questions.



Ask God to help you understand (Psalm 119:13) Ask that God's word will be living and active in your life (Hebrews 4:12) and that He'll show you how to put His word into practice (Luke 11:28) Allow time and space for God to speak to you Context Understand the background of the passage (the setting, perspective, circumstances) **Perspective** Become familiar with what comes before and after the passage Read the passage slowly, repeatedly, aloud, in two or three translations **Imagine** Put yourself into the story - what do you see, hear, smell, taste or touch? Who is in the story, what is happening with them? What are they be thinking and feeling? If you were Jesus in this story what would you be thinking and feeling? Reflect What do you learn about the Holy Spirit, God and/or Jesus? What is the main point? What was God saying to the people this was written to? Ponder What understanding do you get into your life? Try and put the passage in your own words. Choose a key verse – memorise it, put it on your wall or in your wallet

Ask God to teach, correct and train you in His way (2 Timothy 3:16)
